**Proposed FY 2018-19 Operating Budget**

*Sunday, 11:00 am, June 24*

The Church Council is recommending the adoption of a balanced Fiscal Year (FY) 2018-19 operating budget of \$525,151. It will fund all our ministries, pay our staff, and maintain our facility. It also includes a \$36,000 principal payment to our scheduled mortgage payments, effectively leap-frogging us ahead one year in our 3 Year Financial Plan for Facility Expansion & Renovation.

Meeting the proposed budget will require a 2% increase, or \$8,300, in member offerings over current giving. An 8% increase, or \$32,000, would be needed for the larger mortgage and maintenance expense of our planned facility expansion and renovation. The sooner we get to that level, the sooner we can start construction.

The voters will be asked to act on the proposed FY 2018-19 operating budget at the 11:00 am Sunday, June 24 quarterly meeting.
